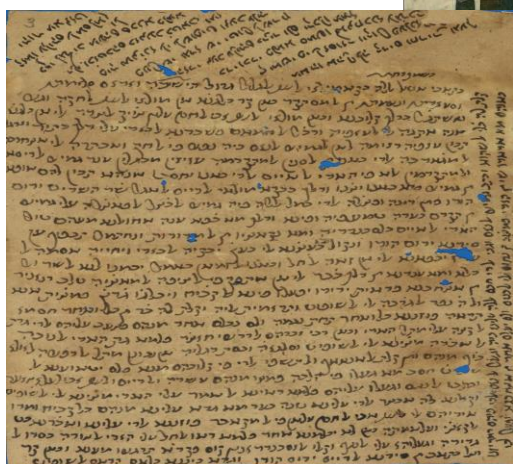




IJS SUMMER CONFERENCE 2016
